Manager's Report By Dave Shelton General Manager, PGA Golf Professional

The golf course is receiving a major face lift and technical improvements in 2017. The conversion of the irrigation communication satellite system to the new Rain Bird system is now complete. This is a totally integrated system that will dramatically improve our ability to control the irrigation of our golf course. Ryan's work on this project saved the club over \$30,000 off of the original bid.

The cart path project will begin when the weather allows, which is hopefully before May. Our original plan was to only put in new cart paths around the tees and greens, but after reaching out to several companies for bids, we found that we could afford to complete the entire golf course cart path system on one side of each hole. The Board of Directors and staff felt that totally replacing the cart paths was of the highest priority, and fortunately we have been able to put together a plan that allows this project to get completed now, instead of piece meal. Very exciting news.

The 2017 membership drive is extremely important to the club, and like all private clubs our success is codependent on our members. We will be focusing our marketing push beginning with the "Masters" and continuing throughout the Spring. If you have anyone that is interested in joining, please contact me directly for additional information, membership packets, and club tours. We have a great clubhouse, golf course, practice facility and staff that work continually to provide an excellent experience for all golfers and families.

April is the month that the annual cart plans are billed to those members who participate in the program. We realize that this is a significant one-time charge to your account, and I want you to know if you prefer to make this payment over two months, normal late charges will not apply.

I began playing golf in 1964, and one of the most important messages that was emphasized at that time was the responsibilities that each golfer has to the game and the golf course. Many things have change about the game of golf in 53 years, but our responsibilities as golfers has not. If we don't repair the damage we do to the golf course who is supposed to? We as golfers are all responsible for repairing our ball marks on the greens, replacing divots in the fairways and rough, raking bunkers and driving power carts in the appropriate areas. ***A red flag on a cart does not give you the license to drive anywhere you want and in fact requires that you use prudent judgement not to damage the course in very wet conditions.*** Yes, we have a grounds crew that maintains the course but using their time to repair ball marks, replace divots and so on, is an extremely inefficient use of resources. Be proactive and help to maintain the course in which you take pride and love.

Golf is deceptively simple and endlessly complicated; it satisfies the soul and frustrates the intellect. It is at the same time rewarding and maddening - and it is without a doubt the greatest game mankind has ever invented.

As Spring finally approaches, we will begin our aerification of the golf course. Aerification is a very important cultural practice for the health of the turf. Benefits include; thatch removal, allowing oxygen into the root zone to promote deeper rooting, improved drainage and aides in maintaining a smooth, firm putting surface.

Aerification of the greens will take place April 3 and 4. The greens will be aerified with a 5/8" tine. Once all the cores are removed from the surface, we will apply and drag sand into the holes. Following completion of the greens, we will aerify and sand the tees, approaches and fairways.

With all of the rain we have had this winter, the bunker sand has been washed out several times. This results in sloped areas having little to no sand. We will once again be checking sand depths in all of the bunkers, adding sand where needed to create a consistent depth and better playability.

I know we are all ready for some good weather and I'm looking forward to another great golf season!
